In Bardstown, Kentucky, **Pedro Gonzalez** came aboard as executive director of food & beverage for **Bardstown Bourbon Company**, overseeing the distillery's restaurant and bar.

In New Orleans, **Mangú** served up modern Dominican cuisine in Gretna. **Saffron Nola** spices up Magazine Street August 10. Closed since Hurricane Katrina, **Gabrielle** makes its triumphant

return in the coming weeks. **Damian Brugger** is opening a second outpost of **Brügger's Barbecüe** at **Brieux Carré Brewing Company**. **Altamura** has shuttered.

In Atlanta, **Jeb Aldrich** checked in as executive chef at the **Clermont Hotel**. **Brian Moll** took over as executive chef at **The Farmhouse at Serenbe**. **Robert Phalen** bumped the opening for **Mary Hoopa's House of Fried Chicken & Oysters** to September.

In Austin, **Joel Fried** launches **Eldorado Cafe** August 8. **Porter Ale House and Gastropub** is no more. **Rebel Pizza Bar** shuttered to make way for **Be More Pacific**, a Filipino food truck venturing into brick and mortar territory.
